

TOGETHER WE CAN SAVE LIVES. OUR MISSION: 1º END GUN VIOLENCE

EVERY YEAR IN AMERICA:

OVER 40,000 PEOPLE ARE KILLED WITH A GUN.

These include suicides, domestic violence murders and unintentional shootings.¹

OVER 1,000 TEENS ARE SHOT AND KILLED.

3,000 more are injured.¹ Firearms are the leading cause of death for children and teens in America.³

OVER 300 CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 11 ARE SHOT AND KILLED.

700 more are injured. The majority are unintentional shootings with an improperly secured firearm.¹

\$280 BILLION IS WASTED.

Americans pay about \$280 billion per year to deal with the immediate, subsequent and quality-of-life costs associated with gun violence.²

TURNING OUTRAGE


Despite the unacceptable gun death rate in this country, the U.S. Congress fails to pass meaningful legislation that would help keep guns out of the hands of criminals and keep our communities safe from gun violence.

JOIN US IN PURSUING COMMON-SENSE MEASURES TO REDUCE AND PREVENT GUN VIOLENCE:

1. UNIVERSAL BACKGROUND CHECKS

Many guns, including ghost guns, are still sold without a background check. Yet, the majority of Americans support universal background checks. SD4GVP demands that Congress pass legislation expanding background checks to ALL gun sales.

You're **25X** more likely to to get shot in the U.S. than in other developed nations.





2. BAN ON ASSAULT WEAPONS AND HIGH-CAPACITY MAGAZINES

Shooters in the deadly mass shootings including Parkland, Las Vegas, Orlando, Aurora and Sandy Hook have all used assault-style weapons and high-capacity magazines. SD4GVP demands that weapons of war be kept out of civilian hands and that highcapacity magazines be limited.

3. GHOST GUN REGULATION

A gun that can be made from easily purchased parts should require a background check and serial number. In the past several years ghost guns have become the gun of choice for criminals and a major problem for law enforcement. SD4GVP demands the regulation of ghost guns.

4. EXTREME RISK PROTECTION ORDERS (ERPOs)

ERPOs, also known as red-flag laws and Gun Violence Restraining Orders (GVROs), allow family members and law enforcement to temporarily remove guns from a person in crisis. ERPOs keep guns out of the hands of those at risk of harming themselves or others. California and 18 other states have enacted ERPOs. We must expand these laws to the entire country.

5. SECURE STORAGE

5.4 million children in the U.S. live in a home with an unlocked, loaded firearm. Firearms are the leading cause of death for children (aged 1-19) in the U.S. The BeSMART program from Moms Demand Action teaches parents about safe ownership of firearms. End Family Fire provides announcements and print resources from Brady to encourage secure firearm storage. SD4GVP promotes both programs.

6. VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION (VIP)

Research shows that VIP programs reduce gun deaths and injuries. SD4GVP supports increased funding for these programs and works to support local, community-based organizations that do this work.





OUR GOALS

BALANCE the need to preserve public safety with the rights of responsible citizens to own and use guns.

WORK legislatively to ensure that guns and ammunition are sold only to responsible citizens.

ADVOCATE for responsible gun-violence prevention laws.

EDUCATE the public about the epidemic of gun violence in this country and how it can be prevented.

ADDRESS specific issues of gun violence including domestic violence, suicide, mass shootings and unintentional shootings.

SUPPORT city, state and national leaders and candidates who share our vision of communities free from gun violence.
